Dear Strata-Tac Customer,

According to Federal OSHA Hazard Communication Standards, each employer has the responsibility to inform its employees of any hazards or dangers associated with the materials used or produced within their facility.

If the materials do not emit hazardous substances and do not pose any type of danger under normal conditions of use, they are exempt from the OSHA Standard.

Strata-Tac products contain no hazardous substances, and are considered non hazardous under OSHA Standard 29CFR1910.1200. Strata-Tac products do not require special clothing, protection or ventilation and no special fire extinguishing equipment or disposal procedure is needed. For these reasons, Strata-Tac does not prepare MSDS sheets for our products.
